That's what our 3rd Sunday service is all about. Starting June 3rd, at 12:15pm, St. John's will offer a new regular Sunday service which aims to be **welcoming and accessible for newcomers** and the "unchurched."

Sometimes our traditions can be overwhelming for visitors and so our 12:15

service will be geared to take away some of the barriers that might keep people away from church. The music of the service will be our most well known hymns featured by piano and occasional guest instrumentalists. The service itself will be a warm and accessible simple Rite II Holy Eucharist, perfect for introducing a friend to our tradition. The service will begin our Summer Season with a hotdog party on June 3rd at 11:30!

Collection dates will be June 18-22



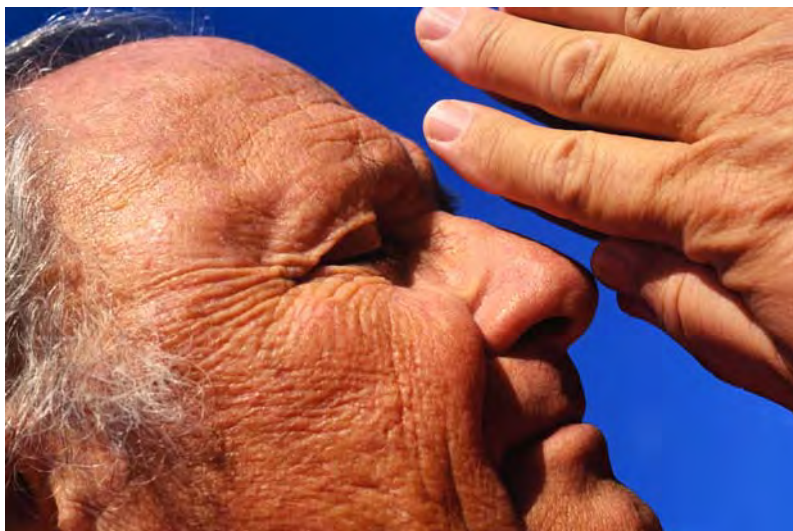
Meditate on it!
